

# Unadilla National — Event Terms & Conditions

## 1. Acceptance of Terms

By purchasing or using a ticket, digital/mobile or paper, you agree to these Terms & Conditions ("T&Cs") and the accompanying Refund Policy.

## 2. Tickets, Admission & Transfer

- **Ticket Types & Ages:**
  - Children under 6 enter free. Ages 6–11 require a child ticket; 12+ requires adult ticket.
  - Limited-access pit passes (for ages 6+) good for pro pit access from 9am-12 noon must be exchanged at Event Center from 6:30am-11:45am Saturday.
  - Drop Zone passes must be exchanged at the Event Center from 7:00am-2:15pm Saturday.
- **Transfers & Reprints:**
  - Tickets may be transferred unless otherwise stated. Lost or stolen tickets are not the responsibility of the organizer.
- **Gate Times:**
  - Thursday camping: 6am.–12 a.m.
  - Friday camping gates 6am-12am
  - Friday & Saturday day access: 7 a.m. gates open. 8 p.m. day parking gates close
  - Sunday gates from 6:00 a.m. until event end.

## 3. Safety & Risk Acknowledgement

- **Assumption of Risk:** Motocross is inherently dangerous. By attending, you assume full responsibility for your safety and that of minors under your care.
- **Behavior & Liability:**
  - Maintain appropriate supervision of minors at all times.
  - The organizer is not liable for personal injury, theft, or property damage.

## 4. Conduct & Prohibited Items

- **General Prohibitions** (violations may result in removal *without refund*):
  - No firearms, weapons, illegal drugs, marijuana, open fires, fireworks, glass containers, personal checks, scaffolding, drones, pit vehicles of any kind (including but not limited to: golf carts, side-by-sides, ATV, UTV, electric motorcycles (ie: Surron or similar), alcohol trackside, unattended minors, banner theft, easy-ups obstructing views, remote-control aircraft, or bicycle riding trackside.
- **Alcohol Restrictions:**
  - Campers: One six-pack per day per person (21+), consumed only at campsite; no glass or kegs.
  - Day Spectators: No alcohol allowed through gates but may be purchased on site
- **Camping:**

- Camping permits one vehicle plus trailer or one tent per spot. RVs allowed with no additional tents.
- Friendly dogs permitted *only within campsites*; service dogs (ADA-marked) allowed trackside. Leashes must remain within boundaries and you must clean up after your pet.
- **Pets:**
  - Day spectators may bring an ADA only marked service animal
  - This is not the event for a pet-too many loud noises, crowds, and sudden movement
- **Quiet Hours & Fire Lanes:**
  - Quiet hours from midnight nightly. Fire lanes must always remain clear.
- **Pit Vehicles:**
  - No pit vehicles of any kind are allowed. Including but not limited to: golf carts, UTVs, 50cc dirt bikes, bicycles with throttles etc. are **not permitted**. A trolley shuttle service operates Friday–Sunday.
- **Medical Disclaimer**

Motocross is a physically demanding and potentially dangerous activity. By purchasing a ticket and attending the event, you acknowledge and agree that:

- You voluntarily assume all risks related to attending the event, including but not limited to, the risk of injury, illness, permanent disability, or death.
- Medical personnel may be present for emergencies, but treatment is provided on a **first aid basis only**, and neither Unadilla MX, its affiliates, nor event staff are responsible for the adequacy or outcome of any medical treatment provided.
- You are solely responsible for any medical costs incurred as a result of attending the event.
- It is your responsibility to assess your physical condition and make informed decisions regarding your ability to attend and participate in event activities.
- Spectators or participants with known health conditions, including but not limited to heart conditions, respiratory issues, or mobility limitations, should consult a physician prior to attending.

If you do not agree to these terms, you should not attend the event.

## 6. Media, Filming & Photography

Attendance includes consent to be photographed, videoed, or recorded for promotional and other uses, with no compensation expected.

## 7. Force Majeure & Cancellations

In the unlikely case of cancellation or alteration due to unforeseen circumstances (e.g., weather, natural disasters), organizers may reschedule or refund in accordance with the Refund Policy.

## 8. Refund & Cancellation

Your payment is subject to our **Refund Policy**, which explains refund eligibility and procedures.

## **9. Privacy & Data Use**

Your personal information will be handled in accordance with the privacy policies of TicketSpice and Unadilla MX.

## **10. Amendments & Enforcement**

- The organizer reserves the right to modify these T&Cs at any time. Changes apply only to future ticket purchases.
- Failure to comply with these terms may result in ejection without refund.

## **11. Governing Law**

These T&Cs are governed by New York State law and any disputes are subject to its jurisdiction.
